



Policy and Procedure for Children's Ministry at New Creation Church post COVID-19

- Upon checking the child into the classroom a brief questionnaire will be conducted with either the parent or guardian of the child.
- Questions will include:
 - Has the child had a fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat, itching, or burning eyes in the last 48 hours? (Exceptions will be made for children teething)
 - Has the child experienced vomiting, diarrhea, or an upset stomach in the last 48 hours?
 - Has the child had a spreading or oozing rash in the last 48 hours?
 - Has the child been exposed to any communicable diseases in the past 2 weeks such as chickenpox, measles, mumps, rubella?
 - Has the child been exposed to head lice in the last week?
 - Are there any new health concerns or medical conditions you would like us to be aware of? (Allergies, diaper rash, insect bites, poison ivy/oak/sumac, etc)
- If any of the above questions are answered “yes” then NCC reserves the right to ask that the child/children stay with their parent or guardian in the Sanctuary.

- If a child begins to exhibit any of the above symptoms a member of the Usher's team will contact the parent or guardian immediately.
- If a child begins to feel feverish, has flushed cheeks (apart from physical activities such as games, dancing, singing, etc), or is experiencing shortness of breath (apart from physical activities such as games, dancing, singing, etc) to a children's ministry team member NCC will provide the parent or guardian a medical grade thermometer and ask that they take the child's temperature and confirm the above symptoms.
